People: Blessed are you when men revile you and persecute you, and say all manner of evil against you falsely for my sake.

Priest: Let us go and look in the graves and see what becomes of man's body. And we shall learn what becomes of wealth, beauty, strength, and comeliness.

People: Rejoice and be exceedingly glad, for great is your reward in heaven.

Priest: Let us listen to what the Almighty cries: "Woe to those who seek to behold the fearful day of the Lord. For that day is darkness; and everything will be tried by fire."

People: Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.
