#### Tour of the Country Parishes (respectfully and affectionately known locally as the Holy Land)

#### Friday, July 28, 2017

On the last day of the Assembly, we have organized a tour of the country parishes northeast of Edmonton. These parishes are among the first Orthodox churches in all of Canada. They continue to be active to this day.

#### The tour will include four parishes:

- 1. Holy Assumption Church, Shandro a church blessed by St. Tikhon in 1905. It also contains a Gospel book given by St. Tikhon.
- 2. Holy Transfiguration Church, Star the oldest Orthodox parish in Canada.
- 3. Ss. Peter and Paul Church, Dickie Bush dates from 1914. The district was settled by Ukrainian pioneers. The church is framed with hand hewn logs.
- 4. Holy Trinity at Smoky Lake It has a cemetery which is the largest Parochial Orthodox cemetery in Canada with over 1300 graves. It is the second largest Parochial cemetery in all of North America. Archpriest and Martyr Fr. Jacob Korchinsky blessed this cemetery.

Date and Time: Friday, July 28, 2017 from 1:30 p.m. to around 9:00 p.m.

Cost of the Tour: \$25.00 for adults and \$10.00 for children

# ARE YOU BRINGING CHILDREN?



We have asked on the registration forms that clergy, lay delegates and observers let us know if they are bringing children. We would also like to know their ages. 'Why?" you ask. Here's why: If enough children attend, we want to organize one or two special activities and/or outings for the children. In order to plan, we need to know numbers of children and their ages.

Our tentative plan would be to organize something special for the children on Wednesday and Thursday (July 26 and 27). We are thinking of age appropriate activities for children between ages nine and seventeen. That is a big age-group range we realize, but if the numbers of children require it, we can divide the children into two groups according to age.

There will be no charge for these activities because the Archdiocesan Council will fund one or two activities/outings for the children accompanying their parents. We have a team of volunteers at St. Herman's who are eager to give the children an interesting and engaging experience.

It is our hope that the Assembly of 2017 is as family-friendly as possible, so we do encourage delegates to consider having their spouses and children accompany them.
