With that word the Master of all was incarnate in you, O Holy Ark.


As the Righteous David said, Your womb became more spacious than the heavens, Bearing your Creator.

### **Troparion & Theotokion**



Now and ever and unto ages of ages. Amen.


O Virgin Mother of God,

### **Troparion and Theotokion**


When the women disciples of the Lord learned from the angel The joyous message of Your Resurrection,

Now and ever and unto ages of ages. Amen.


Rejoice, O impassible Gate of the Lord!

You called Your Mother blessed,


You came of Your own will to the Passion.

### **Troparion and Theotokion**


By Your Cross, You destroyed death!
