

You who dwell in the shel - ter of the Most High,




who dwell in the sha-dow of Al-might - y, will say to the Lord:

Reader: For He will deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the deadly pestilence.




He will co - ver you with His pi - nions and un - der His wings

but none will come near you.



For He will command His an - gels to guard you in all your ways.




On their hands they will bear you up
