**Reader:** If You, O Lord, should mark iniquities, O Lord, who could stand? For with You is forgiveness, that You might be revered.

**People**: *Tone* 2

And in<u>car</u>nate of the Virgin <u>Mary</u>,
Having en<u>dured</u> the Cross,
He was buried as He Him<u>self</u> desired, //

**Reader**: For Your Name's sake I waited for You, O Lord. My soul has waited for the Lord, my soul has hoped on the Lord.

## People:

Christ our <u>Sa</u>viour,
Nailed to the Cross the bond against us.
He <u>void</u>ed it and destroyed the do<u>mi</u>nion of death. //
We fall down before His Resurrection on the <u>third</u> day.

**Reader**: From the morning watch until night, from the morning watch let Israel hope in the Lord.

# People:

With the arch<u>ang</u>els
Let us praise the resur<u>rec</u>tion of Christ!
<u>He</u> is our Saviour, our Re<u>deem</u>er!
He is coming with awesome glory and mighty <u>po</u>wer/
To judge the <u>world</u> which He made!

**Reader:** For with the Lord there is mercy and with Him is redemption, and He will deliver Israel out of all his iniquities.

#### People:

The angel pro<u>claimed</u> You
The crucified and buried <u>Mas</u>ter
He <u>told</u> the women: "Come, see the <u>place</u> where He lay!
He is <u>ri</u>sen as He said
For He is Al<u>migh</u>ty."
We <u>wor</u>ship You, O only Im<u>mor</u>tal One. //
Have mercy on us, O Christ, the <u>Gi</u>ver of life.

**Reader**: Praise the Lord all you nations. Praise Him all you peoples.

#### People:

The gates of death opened to You from <u>fear</u>, O Lord, When the guards of Hades saw You <u>they</u> were afraid, For <u>You</u> demolished the gates of brass and smashed the <u>iron</u> chains//

You have led us from the darkness and the shadows of death and have <u>broken</u> our bonds.

Reader: Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

# People:

Let us come and worship in the <u>house</u> of the Lord, Singing the hymn of sal<u>va</u>tion. <u>Cleanse</u> our sins, O You, Who were crucified and <u>raised</u> from the dead //

And are in the bosom of the <u>Fa</u>ther.

Reader: Now and ever and unto ages of ages. Amen.
