### **Troparia and Kontakia**

#### **Troparion in Tone 2**

Remember the souls of Your servants, O Lord, for <u>You</u> are good, And insofar as they have sinned in this life, forgive them; /// For no one is sinless but <u>You</u>, Who give the departed rest.

Glory...

Kontakion (*Traditional*, music on next page) With the saints give rest, O Christ, to the souls of Your servants, Where sickness and sorrow are no more, Neither sighing, but life everlasting.

#### **Theotokion in Tone 8**

We have you as a wall and a <u>ha</u>ven, And an intercessor well-<u>plea</u>sing unto God, /// Whom you have borne, O Virgin birth-giver of God, the salvation of the <u>faithful</u>.



verse: To You, O Lord, I lift up my soul; O my God, in You I trust, let me not be put to shame!

#### Alleluia:

Blessed are they whom You have chosen and taken to Yourself, O Lord. Their memory is from generation to generation.

#### **Communion Hymn**

Blessed are they whom You have chosen and taken, O Lord. Their remembrance is from generation to generation.

Give rest, O Lord, to the souls of Your servants who have <u>fallen</u> asleep; /// For they have placed their trust in You, our Maker and Fashioner, <u>and</u> our God.
